- Provide guidance, assistance and direction to operating companies on obtaining and maintaining Certificates of Recognition;
- Support the company-wide safety culture through safety training, risk assessments;
- Be the internal lead for other safety initiatives as put forward by your direct supervisor(s) and/or Soletanche Bachy's HSE Global Coordinator.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Manage websites, records and documentation related to safety for the group current (safety registries such as ISNetworld, PICs, ComplyWorks, etc.);
